SUBJ: Sharkey's Shootout Mystery Ball

Magnet Fuse Fatigue:

CPU Software Code 2.04 Update

Symptom:

The Mystery Ball Magnet no longer grabs & holds the pinball.

Problem:

F20, 4 Amp S.B. Fuse, on the *I/O Power Driver Board* (in Backbox) or **4 Amp S.B. Fuse** (located under playfield) for the Mystery Ball Magnet BLOWS once a day, once a week or once a month; replace it and everhting works fine.


Solution:

Replace with new a **4A S.B. Fuse** (remove fatigued fuse) and install **CPU Code version 2.04**. To obtain this version, go to **www.SternPinball.com** and download it from the ROM Code Library.

Explanation:

We have found a software glitch that sometimes will turn the Mystery Ball Magnet on full grab at the end of it's routine for several seconds which can cause Fuse F20 (I/O Power Driver Board) and the Magnets' Under-Playfield Fuse (4A) to fatigue and eventually fail. What causes it to do this is what we call Bog (loading down of the system due to many things going on). If while the magnet routine is running and the customer was repeatedly banging on the flipper buttons, this could create enough Bog for this glitch to occur (even this would be rare since the Magnet only grabs the pinall in Single Ball Play). It will not happen on it's own, only if the system is being bogged down.


